## FOR TRAVEL

- DIRECTIONS**- Several border crossings nearby; the directions we give are the quickest way
- PASSPORT**- a valid passport is required to enter into Canada. You will be denied without it.
- WEAPON DECLARATION**- do not sign until border crossing
- CANADIAN MONEY**- Small fee at border for your weapon. Accepted payment: Canadian funds or Credit Card ONLY
- ArriveCAN app** on phone
- PROOF OF DOUBLE VACCINATION**
- NEGATIVE COVID TEST WITHIN TIME FRAME**

- Camp shoes/slippers**- Lodge has a no shoe policy
- Personal toiletries**
- Medications** in original, up to date bottles
- Clothing**- Pack accordingly for your week stay. We do not have a washer & dryer on site. We can, however, take wet hunting clothes home to dry.
- Fishing rod & tackle**- if you plan on buying a fishing license

## FOR YOUR HUNT

- NB OUTDOORS CARD**  
**\*\*You cannot get a bear license without this\*\***
- Firearm of choice & Ammunition**
- Firearm Case**-Laws require your firearm to be concealed in a case during transport.  
**\*\*See website for more details**
- Safety harness**
- Warm base layer clothing**
- Outerwear, including raingear**
- Hunting/Rubber boots**
- Thermacell**- **\*\*ORIGINAL SCENT REFILL PADS only\*\*** ↙  
\*DO NOT BUY EARTH SCENTED PADS  
\*A DAY OF HUNTING=1 BUTANE & 3 PADS (approx)
- Camera and/or video camera**
- Daypack or backpack**; needed to carry into blind/stand
- Pee bottle**- you are not going to be able to hold it 😊
- Cell phone**- **\*\*Contact your service provider to ensure your cell phone will work in NB\*\*** Must be able to make and receive calls OR texts
- Cooler(s)**- Come prepared to take your meat & hide back with you
-
